The Canadian Dilemma

The OFA has been actively seeking the O Lines in Canada for decades. We have had communication with several long-time members in the upper lands of America. Over the decades there has been progress in getting information, but like many of the old records, some of it is mis-information. There are reasons for this. People move without documentation being left behind. The oldest original deeds and property surveys can be sporatic at best. Cemetary stones either have no names, were written on wooden crosses, or time has washed away the surface of the stone memorial. And in the early years of the 1970's and 80's the lack of information led to several presumptions, from the idea there were so few O's in Canada.

This is a work that compiles the known families that have gone to Canada prior to 1830, in an attempt to properly tie the earliest families together with the documents from what was known as Upper Canada; the land east to west between Niagara Falls and Michigan, and south to north from the Great Lakes to Lake Huron. I list only a handfull of names which are used in documents which cannot be tied to existing families at this time.

AC Abraham is designated as a UE, whereas the IC Isaac line was not a UE. Therefore, AC John Overholt was a son of UE and not married to Sarah Henn. AC5 Anne Overholt was a dau of a UE, and therefore not from the IC Line.



The New OS European Line is now on the Website!

All available records of Oberholz descendants from the 1500's to the 1900's in Europe have been tabulated and corrected from past records. This line is coded as the OS (**O**berholz in **S**witzerland) Line on our website. American Lines which can connect to the European Line have Barbara Ford's coding system in brackets after the OS code number. This reduces confusion for those who are familiar with the present coding system, and yet allows a person to continue their line backwards to the first known Oberholzer, that of Farmer Oberholzer from 1438 CE.
